Who are we?

SALTO Green (*Support, Advanced Learning and Training Opportunities*) is the resource center for green transition and sustainable development. As an initiative of the European Commission, it is hosted by the French Erasmus+ agency.

It is one of 4 resource centers linked to the horizontal priorities defined by the Erasmus+ program:

- environment and the fight against climate change,
- digital transformation,
- inclusion and diversity,
- participation in democratic life, shared values and civic engagement.

It is supported by a team of 4 people and a network of “Green Contact Points”, representing all the Erasmus+ agencies in Europe, i.e. 54 members.

What are our objectives?

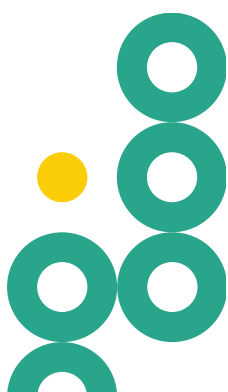
The main objective of SALTO Green is to support the main stakeholders of the Erasmus+ program (national agencies, project leaders, beneficiaries) in the implementation of the green priority:

- reduce the program's carbon footprint
- raise awareness and support training in sustainable development
- provide training in green skills and strengthen the employability for a new green labour market

Why do we launch a call for contributions?

The new SALTO Green website for the general public has been launched. It aims to provide information and tools to help green mobility or cooperation projects, internal procedures, events...

We would like to develop the editorial part of the site with articles to complement the information and tools already available.





The objectives are to:

- strengthen SALTO Green's position as the European focal point for the green transition
- develop a community of experts around the theme of sustainable development and green mobility
- increase traffic to the website, in conjunction with the new LinkedIn page

Conditions

The number of articles to write will be defined once the pool of contributors have been set up.

The texts may take the following form:

- summaries of European or international studies or reports
- interviews with experts or transcriptions of testimonials
- presentation of one of SALTO Green's resources in relation to a specific context (political, usage...)
- ...

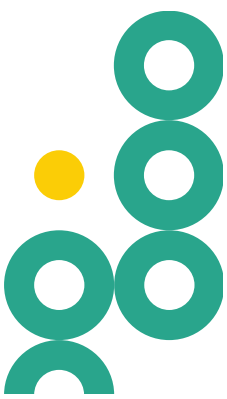
Contributions should address the following themes

- ecological transition and sustainable development in the context of education* and training* and geographical mobility
- ecological transition in public organizations and internal agents of change
- emerging professions and changes in the job market linked to the ecological transition
- green skills and adapting training to meet job market needs
- European policy and regulatory frameworks related to the themes listed above

** All types of training (formal and non-formal), all audiences (schoolchildren, young people, students, adults...), all levels...*

Whatever the theme, articles must include a European dimension: for example, interviewing people with a European background, cross-referencing interviews with people from different countries, comparative analysis between several countries, joint writing of an article between 2 or more contributors from different countries...

In return, they will receive a fee according to the number of signs by article (fees grid available upon request).





Who are we looking for?

To write the articles we need, and depending on the type of article, we are looking for the following profiles:

- experts and/or evaluators involved in European projects or programs, with a particular focus on adaptation to climate change
- journalists and bloggers specializing in the targeted themes
- Master's students (who have benefited from the Erasmus+ program) and young researchers working on the targeted themes.

The list is not exhaustive.

How to apply?

This call is permanent. Applications will be evaluated as they are received.

For this first call, please send the following information or documents before 30 September 2025:

- a CV outlining: your background and experience in relation to this call for proposals; any cooperation you may have set up or networks and initiatives in which you are involved; languages in which you can write
- a half-page text presenting your motivations
- a portfolio of your achievements in connection with this call (ideally in several languages)
